

Pastoral Ponderings ...

Fishing -- on land

I am not usually into poetry, but since poets strive for an emotional response [rather than an understanding of the mind] I found this one intriguing. James A Richards penned his poem focused on Matthew's Gospel 4:18: 25. In that passage we learn Jesus walks on the shore of the sea of Galilee and watches two brothers cast a net in the sea. He calls out to the fisherman, "Follow me and I will make you fishers of men". Thereafter they walked with Him. This is the poem:

I owned a little boat a while ago And sailed a Morning Sea without a fear, And whither any breeze might fairly blow I'd steer the little craft afar or near. Mine was the boat, and mine the air, and mine the Sea, not mine, a care . . .

One day there passed along the silent shore, While I my net was casting in the Sea, A man, who spoke as never man before; I followed him, -- new life begun in me. Mine was the boat, but His the voice, and His the call, yet mine, the choice . . .

Once from his boat He taught the curious throng, Then bade me let down nets out in the sea; I murmured, but obeyed, nor was it long Before the catch amazed and humbled me. His was the boat, and His the skill, and His the catch, and His, my will.

I have wondered why I saved this. I realize that it continues to speak to me and, perhaps even now in 2022, for we are in times of crises where so many issues come to the forefront, seemingly as never before, without letup. What Jesus asked of those two brother sounds so simple. All he asked was, "Follow me". They did. Their life was never the same. Jesus asks you, "Follow me". If. you obey your life will never be the same.

Simon Peter, Andrew, and the millions upon millions who have truly responded to Jesus and followed him away into people's lives where troubling problems cry out to be addressed have realized that it is Jesus' 'boat-world', and His the skill, and His the catch, and, we offer our will to Him. Then, amazed and humbled, we join as Jesus teaches us to cast the net Jesus wants us to cast.



Become a Sponsor for New Members


The purpose of sponsors for new members of our church will be to ensure that they feel welcome.
